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## **FLEA CONTROL**

### **TREAT ALL ANIMALS IN THE HOUSE**

If the house is infested you **MUST** treat the environment. It is wise to treat to prevent fleas rather than waiting until an infestation has occurred. Check every pet weekly for fleas. A flea comb is the best way to look for fleas.

### **ON THE ANIMAL**

Once a month, products such as **REVOLUTION** or **ACTUVYL** are advised for flea control in dogs and cats. **COMFORTIS** is a flea control for dogs. For flea and tick control for dogs, we recommend using **ACTIVYL PLUS**. These products are very effective in removing the flea population, are safe for your pet, and easy to use.

With the recent advancements in flea control, we believe the use of flea powders and dips to be outdated; therefore we no longer advise these.

### **HOUSE**

Households heavily infested with fleas should be treated with flea sprays or bombs. Proper application is vital for effective results, i.e. treating the entire house, spraying under sofas, beds, etc. Our recommendation is an Insect Growth Regulator (IGR) product.

We **strongly** believe that fleas can be effectively controlled with the above mentioned products.

Start treating in May/June and continue through November.
